(1) By its Resolution 21 GA 7, the General assembly of the States Parties to the Convention concerning the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage has decided that the contributions to the World Heritage Fund are set at 1% of each State's contribution to the regular budget of UNESCO. The General Assembly also reiterated the plea of the World Heritage Committee to States Parties to pay their annual contributions by **31 January** in order to facilitate the timely implementation of the activities.

As requested under Resolution 19 GA 8 (<http://whc.unesco.org/en/decisions/6423/>), the Director-General invites States Parties to make unrestricted supplementary **voluntary** contributions to the World Heritage Fund in addition to their mandatory contributions. By its Decision 40 COM 15 (<http://whc.unesco.org/en/decisions/6854/>), the World Heritage Committee endorsed options 1, 4 and 5 of Resolution 19 GA 8, as they were found applicable alternatives. By the same decision, the World Heritage Committee also endorsed the proposal of document WHC-15/20.GA/8 (<http://whc.unesco.org/archive/2015/whc15-20ga-8-en.pdf>) to apply on a voluntary basis a minimum contribution by categories.
